**Newsletters and Invoices**

- Once the term has started, newsletters and invoices will be sent by email. Please let us know at once if you have not received it within 3 weeks of your application being received. Newsletters and Invoices will be sent out before Christmas for the Spring Term, then in March for the Summer Term.
- Fees are payable termly in advance within 14 days of the start of the term. Once registered, pupils are automatically assumed to be continuing their classes from term to term. Notice of Withdrawal of a child must be given in writing at least 5 weeks before the end of the term, or the fees of the following term will be payable IN FULL.
- Open classes are held twice yearly, during the Autumn and the Summer terms.
- Please note that we cannot refund fees in case of cancellation beyond our control (Force Majeure).

**Uniforms Reminder**

Uniforms are available to purchase from our staff on Saturdays at the Chelsea Theatre. **All items must be labelled with your child's name.**

Grade 2	<b>Turquoise</b> leotard and skirt, pink crossover
Grade 3 & 4	<b>Red</b> RAD regulation leotard , navy crossover
Inter F	<b>Royal Blue</b> RAD regulation leotard, navy crossover
Grade 6 and 7	<b>Raspberry</b> RAD regulation leotard
Grade 8	Student's choice

**Modern Hip/Hop:** Pupils should wear a leotard (turquoise or navy/royal blue up to Grade 5 but any colour or style for older pupils), black jazz trousers, ballet or jazz shoes for the "warm up" section of the class. Sneakers may be used during the Hip-Hop class but should be kept specifically for the dance class and should not be used outdoors.

**Shoes and Tights** We don't sell these items but they can be bought at "Six Pieds Trois Pouces" (28 Bute Street SW7 3EY), Peter Jones or from specialist shops such as Freed of London (St Martins Lane).

**Hair** Should be tied back neatly, in a ponytail and a bun is preferred from Grade 1.
